How Rare To Encounter The Dharma

According to the lunar calendar, the day Shinran Shonin passed away is November 28th. (In the solar calendar, it is January 16th.) So, November is a good opportunity to remember the life of Shinran Shonin who spread the teachings of the Nembutsu.

Shinran Shonin wrote at the beginning of Kyogyoshinsho:

**** Ah, hard to encounter, even in many lifetimes, is the decisive cause of birth, Amida's universal Vow! Hard to realize, even in myriads of kalpas, is pure shinjin that is true and real! If you should come to realize this practice and shinjin, rejoice at the conditions from the distant past that have brought it about.***

Amida Buddha vowed to bring all living things to the Pure Land. Shinran Shonin expresses his joy at hearing the teachings. There is a phrase there: Many lifetimes. "Many lifetimes" means that even if we go through many reincarnations, it is difficult to encounter Buddhism. We only live once and cannot repeat, but the life before we were born is called "Kako Se", a past life. Also, the life after death is called "Mirai Se", a future life. Repeated reincarnation and living many lives is called many lifetimes.

When Shakyamuni Buddha was walking along the Ganges River in India with his disciple, he said to his disciple, "In this world, there are many lives other than humans, such as animals and insects." "Their numbers are as many as the sands of this river, and they are innumerable." Then, he put a handful of river sand on his palm and said, "The number of lives that can be born as human beings is as small as the number of sands on this palm."

Then, Shakyamuni Buddha placed a few grains of sand on his thumb nail and said, "The number of people who can encounter Buddhism after being born as human beings is as small as a few grains of sand on my fingernails."

If Shinran had not encountered the teachings of the Nembutsu, Jodo Shinshu temples and sangha might not have existed today. If our parents and ancestors had not met, I would not have existed. Many connections overlap, and now I am able to live this life. I deeply feel that listening to the nembutsu is not natural, but a very precious thing.

Namo Amida Butsu, Namu Amida Butsu.

Governing Board Meeting Highlights
Meeting Date: October 13, 2022

1st Vice President: The Board approved Kyudo Kai (traditional Japanese Archery) to begin using the gym for equipment storage and training on November 11. A new janitorial service has been approved and is expected to begin in early November. Garick Air Conditioning will be providing maintenance service to our units four times per year.

2nd Vice President: The fall food bazaar and the prime rib dinner were both held successfully. Thank you to all helpers and participants!

BWA Report: The BWA will chair the Ladies of Jodo Shinshu Memorial Service, October 23 and New Year's Eve mini-service. BWA-sponsored services will include the serving of refreshments. BWA will be purchasing new tables for the multi-purpose room. The October Dana project is participation in the Run for a Safe Haven held by My Sister's House. For those who could not attend virtually, a station was set up in the multipurpose room for BWA members to participate in the 46th FBWA Virtual Conference. The Rummage Sale is set for November 5. Drop off items November 2, 3 or 4. No large items or clothing. Annual Tsuitou Hoyo rescheduled to December 10.

Dharma School: The new Dharma School Cabinet was installed, and Dharma School activities have begun. Eight students are currently enrolled. A Halloween Party on October 30 will be held, led by the Jr. YBA with the assistance of Activities.

Unfortunately, public school teachers pay for classroom supplies and educational material with their own money because of school budget cuts. The Buddhist Church of Florin supports public school teachers by offering a \$1,500 grant for classroom supplies and education materials; and if necessary, for Personal Protection supplies and equipment.

To be eligible for the Kikuyo and Kinjiro Nakatani Public School Teacher Grant, you must be a full-time public school teacher in Kindergarten through 12th grade; and a member of the Buddhist Church of Florin (church membership dues are paid and current).
