Happy New Year! 2025 is here. In 2024, we shared many events and made many memories together. I hope to make new memories together this year as well and share the teachings of Buddhism and Shinran Shonin.

This year's zodiac sign is the Snake. The Snake is the sixth of the twelve Chinese zodiac signs according to the calendar. The Snake is said to symbolize "revival and rebirth," "wisdom," and "change," and is also said to be a year of new beginnings and a year of "bearing fruit." A year is a long time, and it brings about big changes in our lives. I hope that it brings good changes to all of you. In the teachings of Jodo Shinshu, it is very important that change occurs within oneself. There is a passage by Shinran Shonin in Koso Wasan that says:

Even my eyes are being hindered by blind passions, and I cannot see the light that grasps me. Yet the great compassion of Amida Buddha Illuminates me always without tiring.

[Shinran Shonin / KOSO WASAN 95]

The message of these words is "Buddha is always concerned about me, whether I realize it or not." Buddha is worrying about us and trying to teach us that "your suffering is created in your mind." However, even when we hear this, it is sometimes difficult to control our own minds. And the Buddha says "It is okay. You are fine just the way you are. Live your life as you are, and after you die, I will let you be born in my land (Pure Land), so live your life to the fullest now."

When you hear this, thinking "Well, if I can be reborn in the Pure Land no matter what I do, then it's okay to do bad things" is the wrong way to change. It's like purposely catching a cold because you know there is medicine that can cure most diseases/illnesses.

Instead, we should be happy that we are being watched over by the Buddha who is always concerned about us, and think, "I will repay the Buddha's wish with my actions." This is the change that the Buddha wants us to see.





#### Buddhist Church of Florin Governing Board Meeting Highlights

December 11, 2024

- 1. Sensei Imada is planning a Japanese cooking class where he will lecture on how to make dishes such as Hiroshima-style okonomiyaki and butter and soy sauce flavored spaghetti. Watch for an announcement on the starting date. Also, Sensei holds a Buddhist Discussion group following the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday service and Japanese Study Class following the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday service. Everyone is welcome.
- 2. President Eric Fujii thanked Ann Tsukamoto for her tireless work with our scrip sales fundraiser. This year the program netted over \$2,400. Watch for details on how to purchase scrip in this newsletter, on our website (BuddhistChurchOfFlorin.org), and by email. The program is easy; you purchase scrip and the scrip company rebates a percentage of the sale to the church. Use the scrip for your everyday shopping or for gifts.
- 3. Kyudo-Kai (Japanese archery club) will begin a tradition on New Year's Day. Members will shoot 108 arrows, each carrying a small paper listing one of the 108 worldly sins, into a target, thus cleansing the world of that particular sin. This is a Zen tradition called Joya no Kane and signifies starting a new year fresh and is similar to the ringing of the Kansha Bell 108 times on New Year's Eve. Sangha are welcome to observe this new tradition following the New Year's Day Service.
- 4. Please remember to renew your membership. Membership forms can be found in this newsletter and on our website (BuddhistChurchOfFlorin.org).
- 5. The Hondo kitchen remodel project is planned to begin in mid-March. Since affiliates also use the kitchen, the Board is asking affiliates to contribute to the cost of the remodel.
- 6. Sacramento Kendo has a new Sensei, Shinobu Hashimoto with a 5<sup>th</sup> Dan ranking. Beginning in the New Year, the dojo will have classes on Tuesdays and Fridays for beginners (those without equipment) from 7:00 to 7:50 pm; Members with Kendo Bogu will practice from 8 to 9:30 pm.
- 7. Two benches on the side of the hondo need replacement. There will be a campaign to collect funds in the new year selling bench plaques and bricks like the existing ones that can be seen on the grounds.
- 8. There will be a road improvement project along Florin Road from Franklin Blvd. to Power Inn Road from November 2024 to September 2025. Please be mindful that you may need to consider alternate routes to temple at some times.

#### \$5,000 Scholarship and \$3,000 Scholarship for Graduating High School Students

- Must be graduating from high school this academic year;
- Plan to attend an accredited university, college or vocational school full time next year;
- Your parent is a member of the Buddhist Church of Florin (church membership dues are paid and current before the scholarship application deadline); and
- You have been a Florin Dharma School student prior to enrolling in a university, college, or vocational school.

- Participation in the Florin Dharma School
- Participation in church program activities
- Participation in community programs
- Academic achievements
- Essay (approximately 300 words) on the topic of how Buddhism affects your life
- In-person interview

#### \$5,000 Scholarship, \$3,000 Scholarship, \$2,500 Scholarship, \$1,500 Scholarship and \$1,000 Scholarship for Students Attending a University, College or Vocational School

- Must be attending an accredited university, college or vocational school full time this
  academic year and plan to continue next year full time and for the full year;
- You or your parent is a member of the Buddhist Church of Florin (church membership dues are paid and current before the scholarship application deadline); and
- You have been a Florin Dharma School student prior to enrolling in a university, college, or vocational school


